



## Time To Get Help?

*Parents should seek help if their child:*

- Loses his temper often. Breaks or throws things when angry.
- Gets into trouble at school. Skips school. Has been suspended or expelled.
- Steals or lies.
- Gets into fights. Has threatened another person with a weapon.
- Has injured or killed an animal.
- Sets fires.
- Appears to lack a conscience—does not feel guilt.
- Often breaks rules. Stays out late. Runs away from home.
- Has broken into a home. Has stolen or damaged property.
- Has been in jail. Has been in trouble with the police.
- Has forced someone into sexual activity.
- Participates in self-destructive or indiscriminate sexual behavior.
- Abuses drugs or alcohol.
- Has mentioned or attempted suicide.
