Please note: There are a limited number of Junior Samaritan Volunteer positions available. For consideration into the program, all application documents must be completed and submitted by mail prior to April 19, 2019. During the application process, we expect the student to be the point of contact. The volunteer's maturity is a major consideration for program acceptance. All future correspondence will be via e-mail. Please make sure that after you submit your application by mail, you check your e-mail address for updates. Partially completed applications will not be considered.

Returning Junior Samaritans have priority consideration for acceptance into the 2019 Junior Samaritan Program.

New Junior Samaritan Volunteer applicants will then be considered on a first come, first served basis.

Applicants will receive e-mail notification of their application status by April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2019. If you are not accepted into the program due to space limitations, your name may be put on a waiting list in the event a position becomes available.

A **mandatory** Orientation is required of both Returning and New Junior Samaritans. You may choose to attend one of the scheduled orientations on either Wednesday, May 30<sup>th</sup> or Thursday, May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019, from 3:30pm to 4:30pm. Applicants who are unable to attend an orientation will not be able to participate in the 2019 Junior Samaritan Program.

New Junior Samaritans: If you are accepted into the program, your record of immunizations is required. If you do not have a copy of your immunization record, please request a copy of this form from your school or doctor's office. You will be required to bring your immunization record to a scheduled Health Screening (which includes a TB test done by blood draw).

Returning Junior Samaritans: You will be required to attend a scheduled Health Screening (which includes a TB test done by blood draw). Your immunization records are already on file, and you do not need to bring those to the Health Screening.
