


Prevent Head Lice







- Talk to your child about head lice. Tell them not to share brushes, combs, hats, towels, sports equipment or hair ribbons.
- Teach your child to hang his coat on a separate hook at school. Do not let the coat lie of the floor.
- Tell the school, daycare and friends' parents if your child gets head lice.



Signs & Symptoms of Head Lice

- Itching. Open sores may form cause your child scratches.
- Lice and nits (eggs) in hair.
- A tickling feeling in your hair.
- Never use lice treatments to prevent head lice.
